Bachelor of Science in Metaphysical Studies (BSMS)

This program is a foundational program using classic texts from the field of Metaphysics. You will complete 50 lessons, each quizzed in various formats including essay, multiple choice, and true/false. You will complete three book reports on each of the following three books. The quizzes are based on three classic texts in Metaphysical subjects including:

The Master Key System by Charles F. Haanel

As a Man Thinkith by James Allen

Thought Vibration (or the Law of Attraction in the Thought World) by William Walker Atkinson

All courses at this level can be completed online and textbooks are available online free of charge. Students have a maximum of one year to complete these studies at the bachelor's degree level. An extension may be granted, however any student putting forth any real effort should be able to complete this accelerated program in much less time than a year.

Degrees are awarded through the Universal Church of Metaphysical Practice, Inc. and all degrees are religious in nature. We are a legal 501(3)(c) church exempt from licensure by the State. We provide ordination to ministry as a component of our bachelor's degree program. Your certificate of ordination will be conferred when you complete the requirements for this program. Included in this program are the UCMP Ministers Handbook, including meditations, affirmations, prayers, and scripts for religious services including weddings and funerals.

Master of Science in Metaphysical Studies (MSMS)

This program will use current textbooks related to the area of concentration that you have selected for your doctoral degree. All textbooks will be supplied. They will be sent via the post office, students outside of the USA will be invoiced an additional \$50 for international postage. This covers the postage for your books, diplomas, packaging, and other correspondence fees as an international student. You will complete quizzes and book reports for each of the required texts, and all graduates must write a 5,000 word thesis on the metaphysical topic of their choice prior to graduation.

For example, if you have chosen to earn a Ph.D. in Therapeutic Meditation you will receive the following textbooks to complete your Master of Science in Metaphysical Studies degree:

(This program also included several hours of additional video presentations, that are all available via streaming video on the internet.)

In any of our programs, textbooks may be substituted based on availability from the publishers. And depictions in this catalog are only for representational purposes. Textbooks used are real books available from any major retailer (such as Amazon) but are included in the cost of your program and will be shipped from our offices.

You may change your area of concentration anytime before you start the Master's Degree program, but once you make this selection, there will be a \$50 charge to change majors, and you will have to return the materials unused if they have already been sent. Graduates of our program who wish to earn an additional Doctoral Degree may do so in any subject for a donation of \$395 and must complete the degree requirements of the additional doctoral degree program.

Students have one-year from the completion of the B.S. In Metaphysical Studies to complete the Master's Degree program.

Doctoral Degree Programs:

Degree requirements for all of our doctoral degree programs are the same. It will involve independent study and a minimum 12,000 word dissertation in the field of your choice. Your faculty adviser will work with you do help you find texts, resources and construct this dissertation. Although we usually require the written dissertation, in some cases (such as those interested in Fine Art or Sacred Music), a final project, composition or exhibition may be substituted. This substitution will rarely be granted, and the final project must have approval from faculty before beginning your work.

Textbooks used will be those used to complete your Master's degree program, and additional resources available from public libraries, your own library of resources, the Internet, or traditional booksellers.

Doctor of Metaphysical Science (D.Met.)

This degree is considered a professional doctorate and one who completes this degree can call themselves a Practicing Metaphysician. This is the pathway for those

interested in a broad range of metaphysical subjects and enjoy independent study. Metaphysics is a broad area and you will have considerable freedom to study the subject most interesting to you within the umbrella of metaphysics.

Doctor of Religious Education (D.R.E)

This is considered a professional doctorate, and is a degree path that one should pursue if they intent to teach, write or develop course materials for metaphysical ministries.

Doctor of Divinity (D.D.)

This degree is considered the Queen of the Metaphysical Theology programs, and courses of study include Biblical Study, study of Sacred Texts, and theology. This degree is post often associated with those choosing to pursue a path as a pastor of a congregation. It is sometime abbreviated D.Div. Rather than D.D. And you may use either description.

Doctor of Theology (Th.D.)

This is a professional degree focusing on the historical theology of the American Metaphysical Movement as a religious practice, and will comprise study in the traditions of Religious Science, Divine Science, Christian Science, New Thought and Universalism. This is a formal degree choice, designed to those who wish to practice ministry in the role of theologian.

Ph.D. And D. Min. Programs

Students may choose either the D.Min title or Ph.D title. Degree requirements are the same as our professional doctoral programs, and students must complete a 12,000 word dissertation or in some cases a final project. If you are interested in a course of study not listed here, please contact our office *prior* to enrollment to see if we can offer a program tailored to your unique needs.

•**Metaphysical Science**

The course of study in this program will focus on metaphysical subjects related to theology, practice of metaphysical healing and general metaphysics. Students will have much latitude to choose areas of concentration unique to their own desires. Subjects ranging from New Thought theology to the akashic records, psychic phenomena, channeling, the New Age and many other subjects may be included in your studies as you desire.

•**Health Care Ministry**

For those interested in health care ministry, chaplaincy, or related subjects this program will be of tremendous value. Those with backgrounds in medical or healing

disciplines will find this an exciting way to improve skills and gain recognition.

•**Thanatology (Death and Dying)**

We are very excited to offer this program. Few schools offer a degree specifically focusing on ministering to individuals and families during life transition culture refers to as death. This course is an exciting opportunity for those in the hospice, funeral or metaphysical professional to learn applications of metaphysical truth to assist in meeting the spiritual needs of families during this time. Students may also focus on the process of death, grief and loss and use this education as a tool for metaphysical ministry in the manor they see as most helpful to others.

•**Contemplative Theology**

This course of study will focus on the faith traditions associated with contemplation and mediation including Taoism, Buddhism, and other Eastern religions. Students will be outline theological beliefs and relate these to ministry in today's world.

•**Energy Work and Healing**

The power of Qi (Ch'i). Energy workers encompass a broad variety of disciplines including traditional methods of acupuncture, massage therapy, healing touch, vibrational medicine and many other esoteric methods of healing. This program explores the theoretical basis for healing through energy, and teaches graduates to utilize the power of the life force to minister to those in need

•**Sacred Wisdom**

Sacred wisdom can come from a variety of traditions. Celtic, Nativist, and Wiccan traditions have many writings offering Sacred Wisdom, as do Christian traditions, and those of other religions. Students may study akashic records or any other mystical paths of wisdom of interest. You will study the pathway most important to you, relating the words of wisdom from sacred texts to you ministry goals.

•**Metaphysical Hypnotherapy**

Hypnotherapy is one of the most useful tools available to help individuals with life goals and spiritual healing. Our program assumes you have taken a basic hypnosis certification program, but for those who have not, we can arrange for an additional certification program exploring the fundamentals of hypnosis and how to conduct hypnotherapy sessions. There is an additional charge for this if you do not currently hold certification in hypnosis from a recognized hypnosis certification program. Metaphysical hypnotherapy will specifically focus on spiritual applications of this healing art.

•**Therapeutic Meditation**

There is no tool more useful than meditation to promote physical wellness, spiritual balance and emotional growth. Mainstream psychology is finally discovering that mindfulness meditation, from a Zen tradition, is a tool bringing success to patients that previously were viewed as unable to make changes. Our program draws on current research, current methods of practicing this ancient art of mindfulness meditation with a focus on using therapeutic mediation as a tool for ministry in a variety of settings.

•**Spiritual Yoga**

The popularization of yoga is no mystery to those who recognize the value of the many branches of yoga in balancing both spiritual, physical and mental health. This course will study yoga at a deeper level, allowing you to develop deep insights in the many forms of yoga including Hatha, Vinyasa, Iyengar, Ashtanga, Bikram, and Kundalini and other forms of yoga.

•**Comparative Religion**

Students in this program will compare and contrast the beliefs and practices of the major world religions, and relate them to modern metaphysical practice. This degree course is ideal for teachers of wisdom, writers who need a broad base of knowledge and those interested in the practices of world religions.

•**Mystical Psychology**

Carl Jung brought the influence of the mystical to the front and center in the field of psychology. This course of study will help you to integrate Jungian philosophy into the metaphysical practice of psychology. An ideal degree path for those who practice counseling, psychotherapy or metaphysical ministry on an individual basis. This is a very practical course, and you will enjoy the learnings you take from this program.

•**Substance Abuse Ministry**

The book *Alcoholics Anonymous* forever highlighted the need for spiritual paths to be a part of long-term recovery from addiction. The professional recovery community recognizes a spiritual basis for recovery, and mystical texts and affirmations have long been a part of the formal recovery process. For those intending to minister to substance abusers, and meet the needs of those with other addictions, this program is perfect. Though our educational partner and curriculum provider, we can also offer to some students, approved CE hours through NAADAC for your substance abuse certification re-licensure. Contact faculty adviser for more information on how those already certified as substance abuse counselors can use these CE hours. We do not offer courses for those seeking initial certification through

state agencies or credentialing commissions.

•**Religious Education**

If you intend to teach others this course of study will prepare you to teach metaphysical principles in classroom, seminar, and church settings. This is an ideal degree for those who intend to write or pursue other educational ministries within the field of metaphysics

•**Holistic Counseling**

Our Holistic Counseling degree program will prepare you to provide ministerial counseling using a model of problem solving that is meta-theoretical in orientation and useful in individual, family and group counseling ministries. This course will integrate metaphysical beliefs into the practice of Holistic Counseling, focusing on body, mind and spirit.

•**Criminal Justice Ministry**

American society has created an entire generation where the criminal justice system provides services one reserved for social work, ministries, and the family. This course of study will explore the problem of incarceration, and offer solutions to those working within the system as metaphysical ministers to effect change in the lives of individuals.

•**Non-Profit Management**

As metaphysical churches and organizations begin to grow beyond the small groups that historically have dominated the field to large organizations providing services to hundreds and even thousands of people, the need for managers capable of handling the management of non-profit organizations is very real. This course explores the fundamentals and laws of no-profit organizations, and will assist those with either large or small ministries to effectively manage these organizations within the legal framework of American corporate structure. This course covers topics unique to American students, and although our international students are welcome to take this program, textbooks used will rely on an American model of corporate structure.

•**Paranormal Research**

The study of metaphysics is the study of that which is beyond the physical. Paranormal research students will write a dissertation covering paranormal research and make a case for the existence and awareness of paranormal phenomena.

•**Applied Feng Shui**

The popularization Feng Shui opens the doorway to metaphysical ministry

through the application of techniques and principles rooted in a spiritual tradition of energy work and its application. Feng shui speaks to the profound role of magic, mystery, and order in American life and various schools of thought will be studied, all with a metaphysical foundation and understanding rooted in Ancient methods.

•**Spiritual Leadership**

In every field leadership training is the most sought after training. In the area of spiritual leadership churches seek those with knowledge and direction, ministries train lay-leaders and at the heart of metaphysical success in life is the ability to lead others. This foundational program in leadership is a valuable program designed to equip you to be an effective leader in the metaphysical community.

•**Consciousness Studies**

Christ-consciousness, awareness, oneness, all of these are elements of metaphysical truth. Our program in consciousness studies will help you to maximize your own potential for awareness and consciousness and to work in a way that enlightens others.

•**Parapsychological Research**

ESP, intuition, clairvoyance and other psychic phenomena are all parts of our para-psychological research program. You will enjoy formalizing your studies in this field and will be able to more effectively communicate your qualifications in this area upon completion of our Ph.D. Program in Parapsychological Research.

•**Metaphysical Law**

Spiritual law encompasses formal study in the natural laws that govern our universe. Over 100 spiritual laws are studied in this program. These powerful laws, including the Law of Attraction, the Law of Karma, the Law of Grace, will be expounded upon at a level deeper than most bringing them to life in your world and allowing you to minister using these powerful spiritual laws.

•**Christian Universalism**

Once considered a taboo subject among Christian believers, the gospel of inclusion and the principles of Universalism are gaining renewed interest as mainstream Christian ministers begin to support universalism and recognize that the gospel of grace is a fundamental part of the Christian faith and that Christ's ministry was to all people.

•Native American Religious Studies

The religious traditions of the Native American populations have a rich and deep history. The powerful rituals and awareness's are all part of this program. You will explore the history and traditions of Native American Religion and see how these principle can be integrated into metaphysical ministry.

•LBL/PLR Studies

More than half the world's population holds the belief in some form of reincarnation or life between lives. This program explores these beliefs and methods of understanding past life experiences and prepares one to use regression techniques to help clients, and although not required a prior knowledge or certification in hypnosis is very helpful. For those interested we can offer for an additional charge hypnosis certification and a course in the fundamental of clinical hypnotherapy.

•Holistic Life Coaching

Life coaching, encompassing financial coaching, physical coaching, wellness coaching and helping people to manifest their dreams cannot be separated from a foundation of spiritual truth. This program will maximize your coaching abilities by focusing on the core skills of effective coaching, and providing a metaphysical foundation to apply these skills. Graduates also receive certification from the college and can call themselves a “Certified Holistic Life Coach” using the CHLC designation.

•Mysticism of Kabbalah

Kabbalah is one of the most ancient mystic traditions, intentionally kept secret for thousands of years. In 1995 all of the Kabbalah writings were made known by the Jewish mystics who held them and Kabbalah encourages those to study the wisdom of Kabbalah, even those from different cultures and faith traditions. Metaphysical ministers will find special value in our comprehensive Kabbalah degree program and will derive great value and meaning in these studies.

•Sacred Music

Perhaps nothing is more healing to the soul than music and sound. Our bodies are programed to respond to healing vibrations and music. This program of study is a wonderful course in vibrational healing, understanding binaural technology, and general music. Students in this program are expected to have musical talent and gifts expressed through performance, composition or technology. In this program, a final project can be substituted for the dissertation if it expresses the goals of this program in a meaningful way.

Students in this program are expected to have unique artistic talents in theater, print media, graphic design, paint, sculpture, poetry or any other are are artistic talent and expression. Three Payment Options.

- **Option 1.** Payment in full offers a 20% discount.
- **Option 2.** Payment of 1/4 of the degree program, followed by three equal payments every 30 days until the balance is paid earns a 10% discount.
- **Option 3.** Pay \$159 down, and equal monthly installments of \$100. No tuition discount, but this is interest free. There is a \$129 fee for this service.
- *Textbooks for the masters level will only be sent after completion of the Bachelor's degree program if you are on a payment plan. 33% of fees due must be paid before the Bachelor's degree will be awarded, 66% must be paid before the Master's degree will be awarded, and the balance must be paid in full before the Doctoral degree is awarded.*

Additional Fees:

- Returned check fee of \$35 per returned check.
- Late payment fee of \$10 per month, payments can be due on either the 1st or the 15th of the month. Payments are late when they are more than 7 days past-due.

Textbook Costs:

- Tuition includes required text books, video and audio will be delivered online only, hard copies of textbooks will be sent by US postal mail. Foreign students must pay an additional postage fee of \$50 that will be invoiced after you are formally accepted to the program.
- Payments are due on the first or the fifteenth of the month. After the seventh day, a late fee of \$10 per month will be added to the account. After 90 days late, your enrollment will be suspended until fees are brought current. A reinstatement fee of \$25 must be paid on deactivated enrollments.

Refund Policy:

- Withdraw from the program within 30 days of enrollment. 100% of tuition paid will be refunded, less a \$200 administrative fee. Any materials that have been shipped must be returned unused before a refund is issued. Withdrawal requests must be sent via certified mail to our offices.
- After 31 days, no portion of tuition or fees is refundable.
- After 90 days of no contact from a student, and no payment, you will be deactivated. You can be reinstated by contacting our office and paying a reactivation fee of \$25 and all payments must be brought current prior to reinstatement.
- Students who owe a balance; even if they choose not to finish studies, will be charged for the entire balance due unless they have formally withdrawn from the program within 30 days.

Scholarship

Like all students, you are enrolling in our combined degree program. The first degree awarded will be your Bachelor of Science in Metaphysical Studies (The B.S.M.S. Degree program). Many students already have a bachelors degree, however our program is designed to be foundational and is also our pathway to ministerial ordination.
